

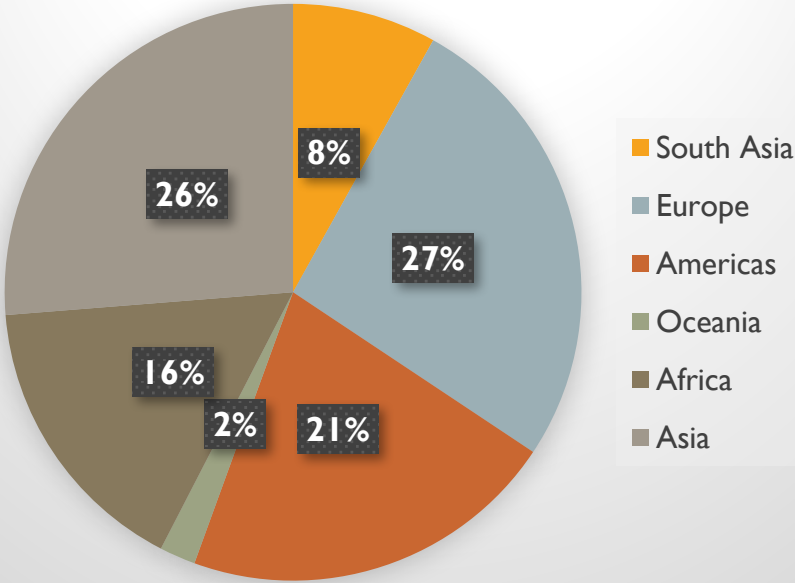

# YES, THERE ARE SCHOLARSHIPS!

- 2016 tuition: \$1,000 (includes all processing fees + instruction + housing + three meals a day)
- Half of all students attend the program for FREE!
- Travel grants also available to students who qualify
- To apply for need-based scholarships:
  - Complete “Scholarship” section in application
  - Write a short statement explaining financial situation (250 words)
  - Provide supplemental documentation (bank statements, other investments)
- Scholarship awards will range from \$500 to \$1000

- Unofficial school transcript
- Resume (1-page, please)
- One letter of recommendation
- Test scores (NOT required)
- \$0 application fee!
